

OMNI – Alexa Setup Up Instructions

Introduction

Please follow these steps to get your OMNI setup on Amazon Alexa.

Plug your light fittings into the 6-way connection block on the OMNI controller.

Plug the DC jack cable from the LED driver into the OMNI controller.

Turn on the mains power to the LED driver.

(Above Android 5.0) or Scan below QR-code to download APP.

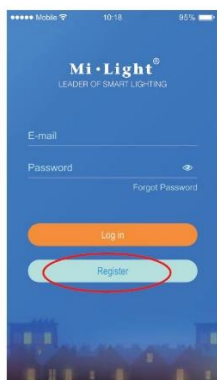


Scan QR Code to Install APP



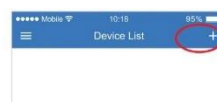
Register Mi-Light Cloud Account

Open APP and click Register button; Complete the register and log in.

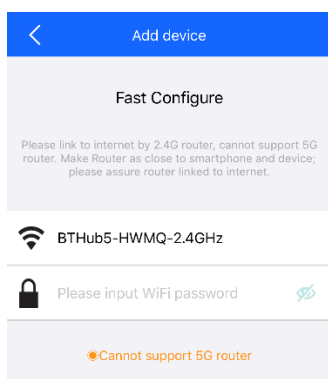
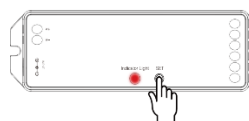


Add Device

1. Click the right top "+" on the device list.
2. Please select the device type you will add, then complete the adding according to the hint of APP.
3. Back to device list after adding successfully, then pull down refresh in list to get the device status.

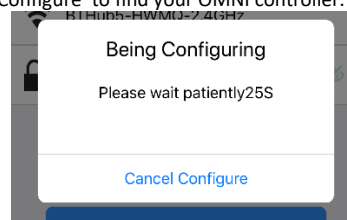


Please select the 5 in 1 strip controller after clicking the "+"
Press and hold the 'Set' button for 3 seconds until the lights are flashing.

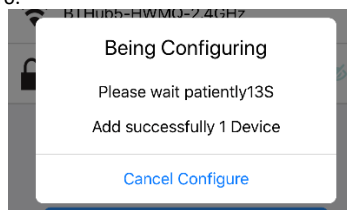


Select your WIFI router and add in your password.

Click 'Start Configure' to find your OMNI controller.



When your device is found it will show below. Let the timer run down to zero.



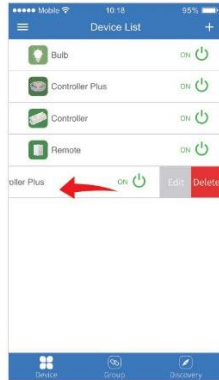
Once complete go back to the device list and pull down to refresh the list. Your device should now show. If it does not, please close and re-open the Mi-Light app.

OMNI – Alexa Setup Up Instructions

Modify device name or delete device

Slide device list to left, click "Edit" to modify device name; click "Delete" to delete device.

Note: If the device was shared to others, then the device will also be deleted on your friends' device list.

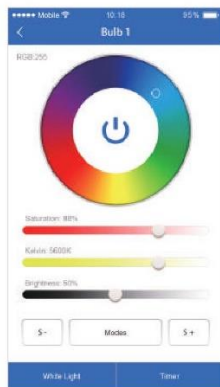


APP Control

Click the device or group that you want to dim on device list and group list into Dimming Interface.

Click Speed+ under dynamic mode.

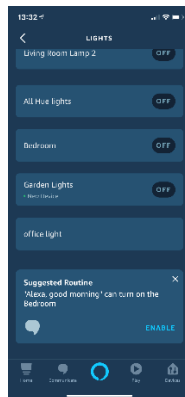
Click Speed- under dynamic mode.



Ask your Alexa app to 'search for new devices'. Alexa will then search and find the OMNI controller.

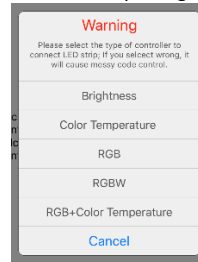
Click on 'Devices' from the menu and select lights. You can now find the OMNI controller in this list. Click on the controller and then on the setting icon.

Rename the controller to what you would like this to be called. For example 'Office Light'. This is what Alexa will recognise this controller as.



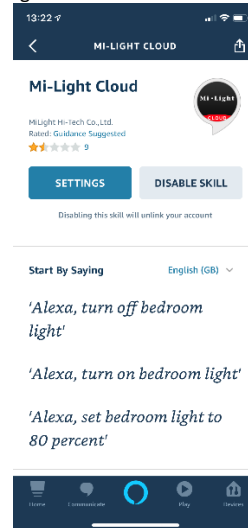
Click "Change" to select the type of controller to connect LED strip; if you select wrong, it will cause messy code control.

Click change in the top right-hand corner and select RGB. This will bring up the correct controller for your light strip.

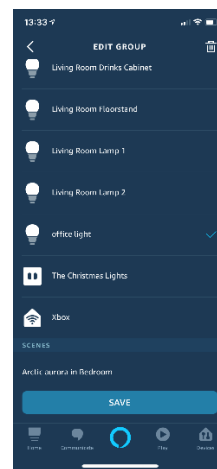


Now open your Amazon Alexa app. In the menu select 'Skill & Games'.

Search for the Mi-Light Cloud skill and enable it.



You can also setup or add this to an existing room on the Alexa app and group multiple OMNI's together.



OMNI – Alexa Setup Up Instructions

Examples of commands for an RGB strip. Replace Office Light with the name you have given the OMNI controller in the Alexa app.

“Alexa turn office light red”

“Alexa turn office light off”

“Alexa turn office light on”

“Alexa turn office light to 50%”

“Alex turn office light to 100%”
